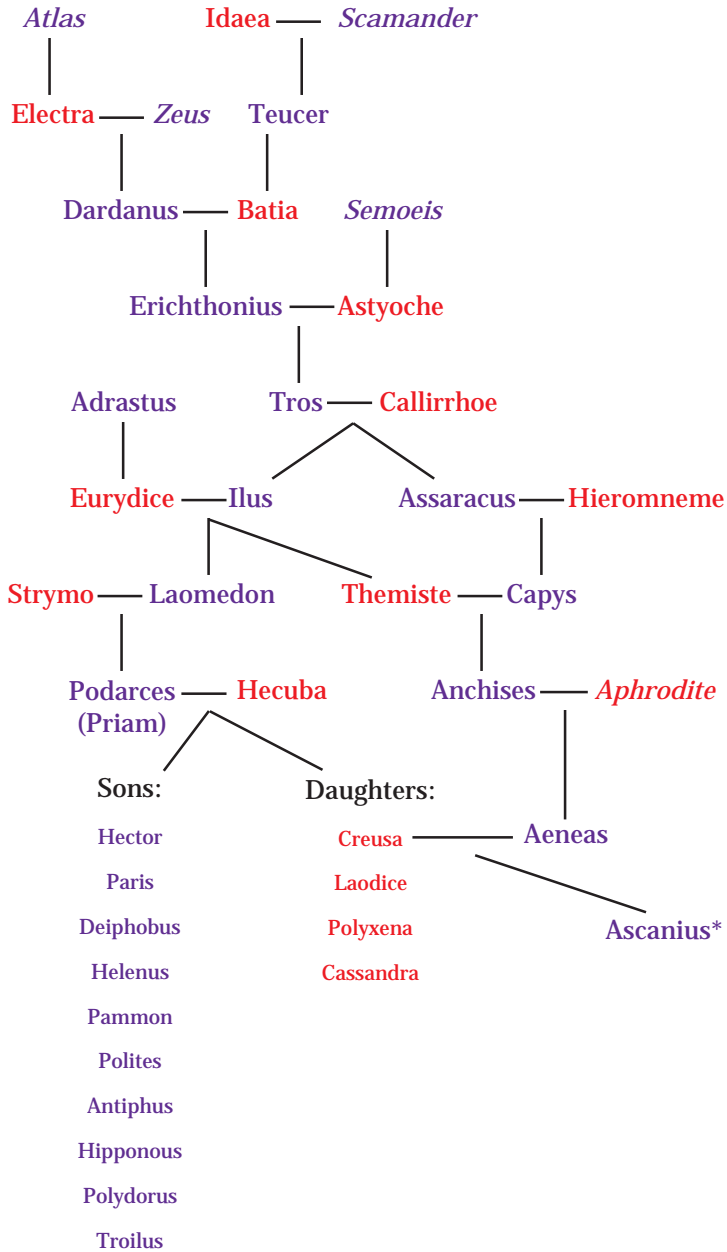

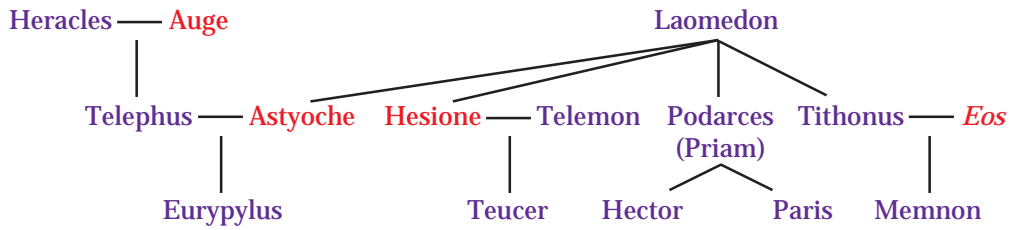

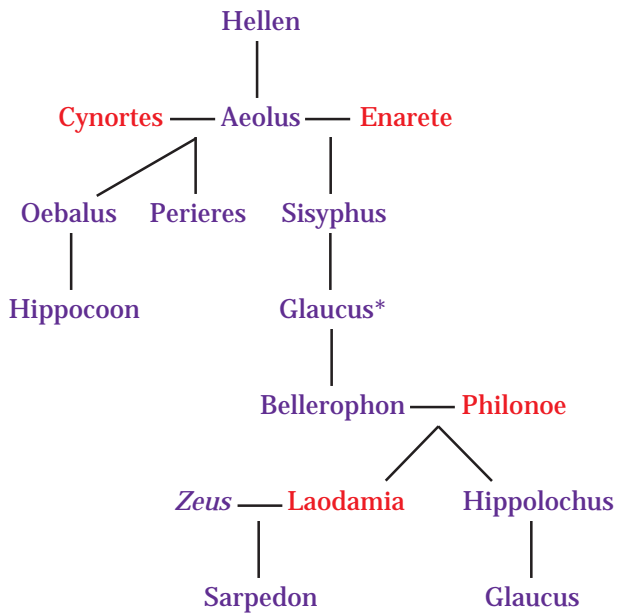


*A Virgilian addition to the Genealogy.

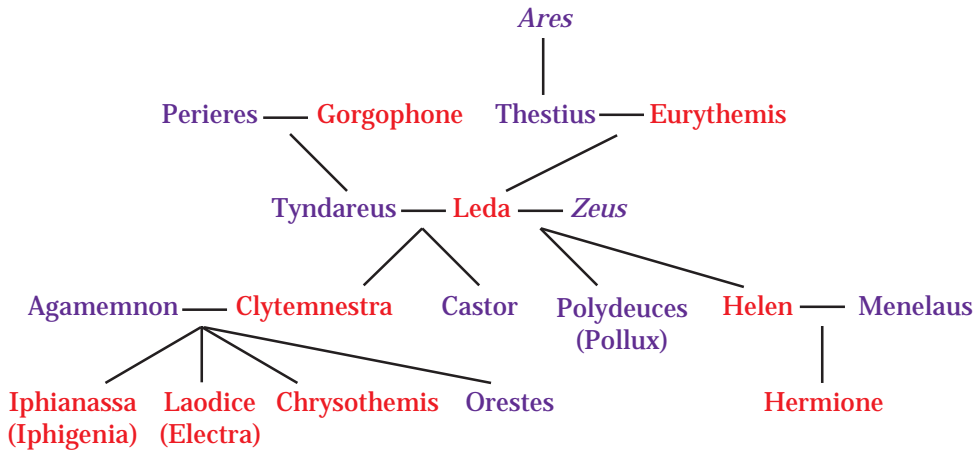

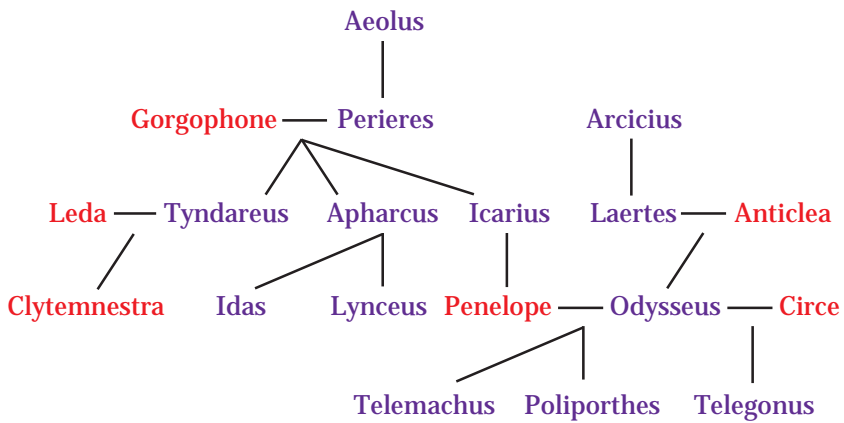


*Not to be confused with Sarpedon's co-commander, Glaucus son of Hippolochus.

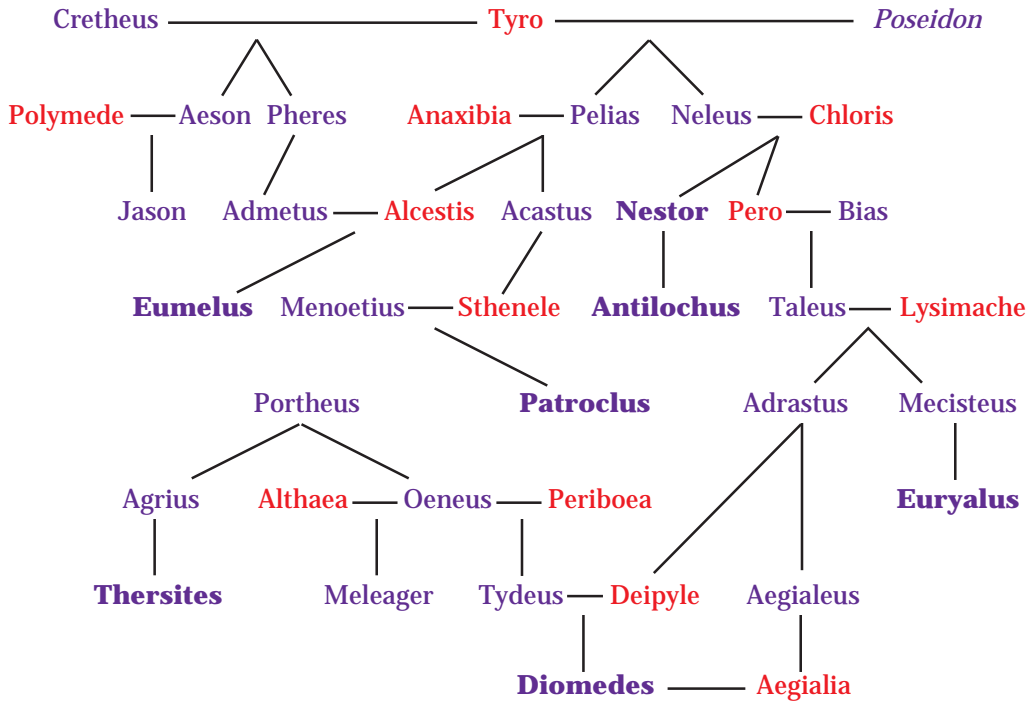

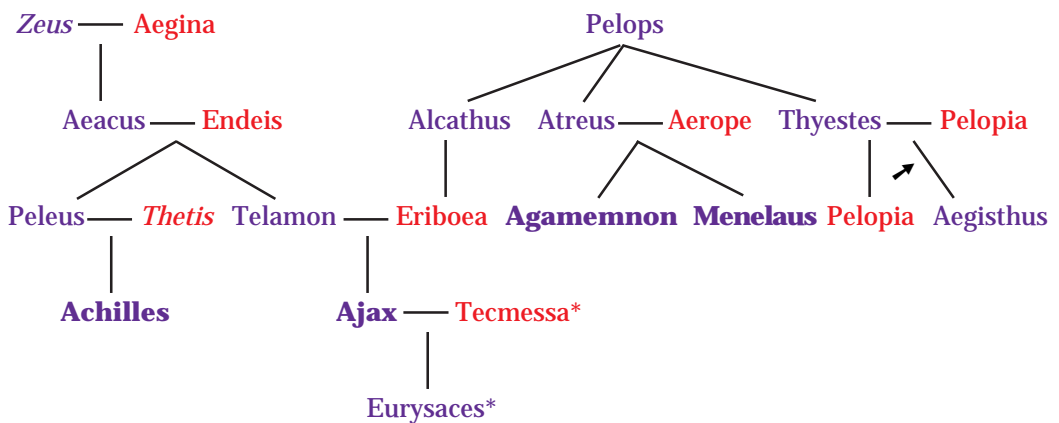

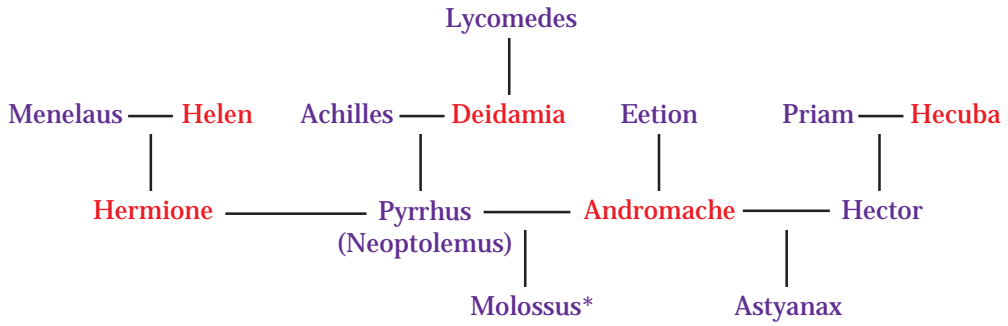

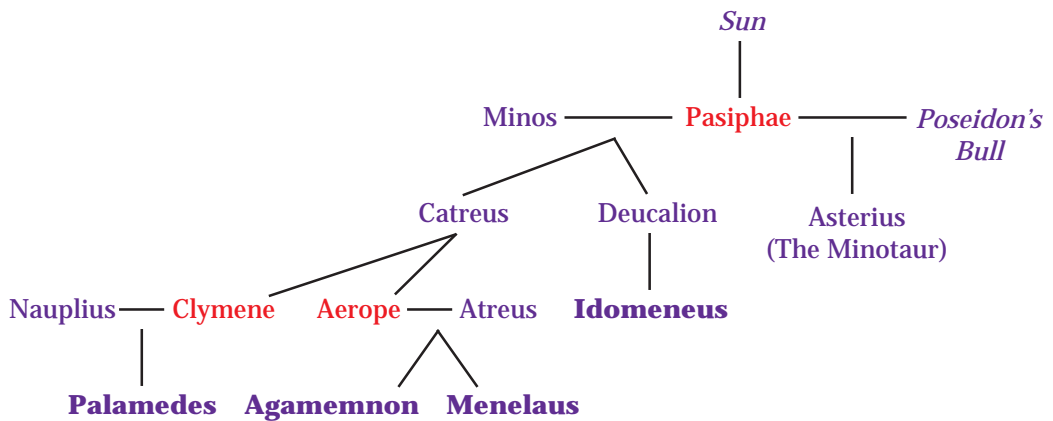
